

## Advice from the Factory

"Advice from the Factory" is submitted by the Parts & Service department at Georgie Boy Mfg, Inc. We hope this information is helpful to you and adds to your camping enjoyment!

If your motorhome will not be used for several weeks, you should perform certain procedures to maintain its performance capability over that period of time.

When storing your vehicle, it should be covered if at all possible to avoid damage from the sun and other environmental elements. Wash the vehicle prior to storing it. This will remove any road and environmental contaminants. Make sure all windows, vents and roof air conditioners are tightened down and all seats are free of gaps.

<u>Kitchen Appliances</u>; Refer to the manuals provided by the manufacturers of the appliances.



Furnace Fan and Thermostat: Make sure both the furnace fan and thermostat switches are in the off position.

Electric Step: Shut off the switch located by the entry door.

<u>Auxiliary Battery Disconnect Panel:</u> This is an OPTIONAL feature on your motorhome. If your vehicle is equipped with this option you will be able to disconnect the coach batteries from the 12V system. This should prevent any inadvertent draining of the coach batteries.

Water System: Refer to the blow-out procedure in your Georgie Boy owners' manual under the plumbing section.

Fuel System: During periods of extended storage, gasoline may deteriorate due to oxidation. This can damage rubber and other polymers in the fuel system and can clog fuel lines. A commercially available gasoline fuel

stabilizer (STA-BIL or equivalent) should be added to gasoline powered vehicles. For diesel powered vehicles, "Fire Prep 1000" or equivalent should be added when storage may last 60 days or longer. Follow the instructions supplied by the makers of these products.

While your vehicle is in storage, you should start your coach every 10-14 days, and allow it to run for 30 minutes. While the vehicle is running, you should shift the transmission into all gears. Also, refer to the chassis operator's manual for more detailed extended storage information.
