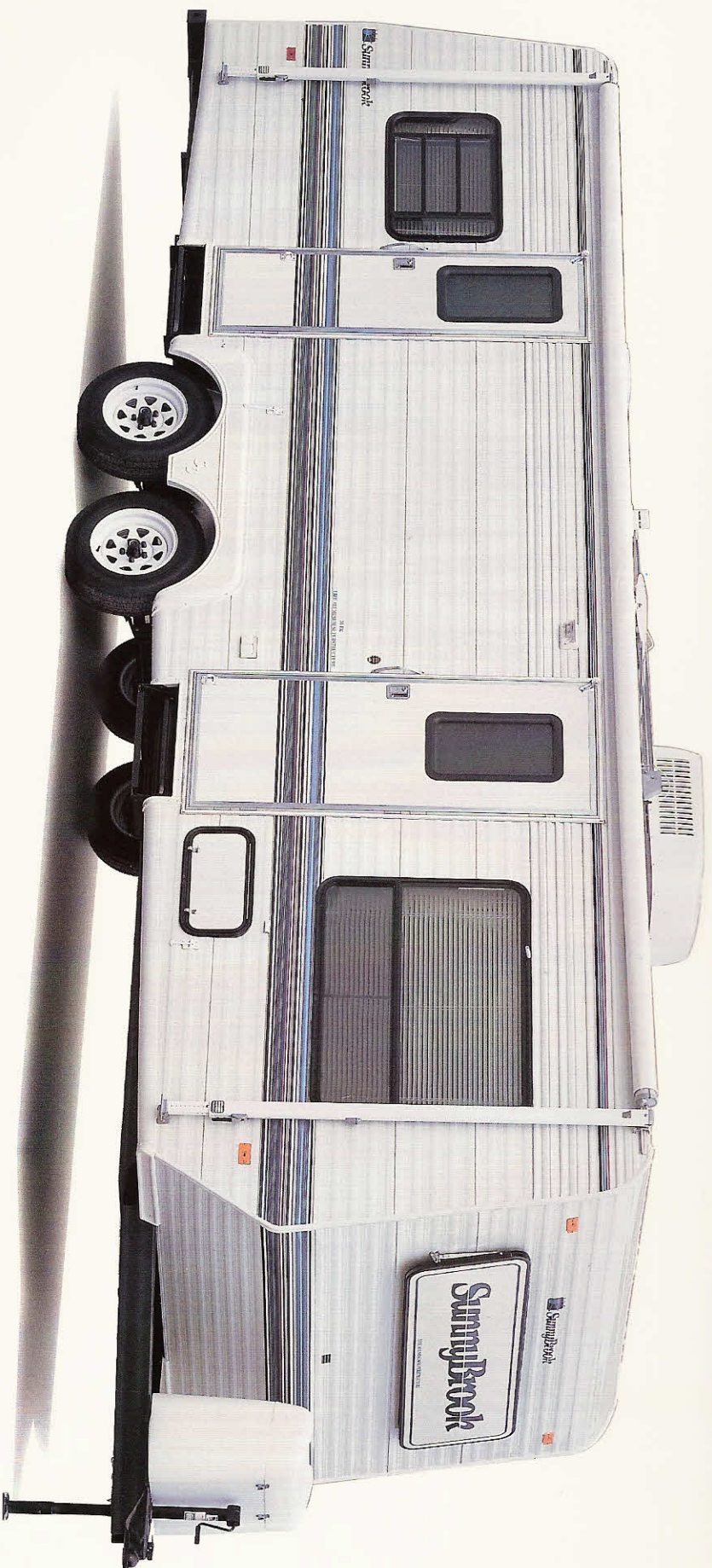

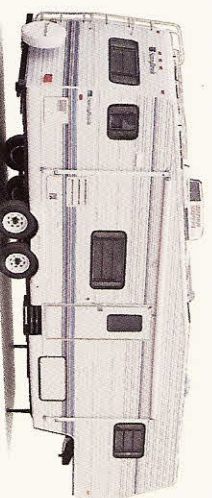

To complement the aluminum superstructure, better quality componentry and construction techniques are used throughout. Compare just a few: We use exterior-grade plywood made from real Western Fir adding a solid foundation to the floor, dinette seats, and beds. You get standard, full-

wrap Form-Cor insulation in addition to complete blanket fiberglass insulation. Ducting systems are uniquely designed to run through the aluminum roof-truss structure. 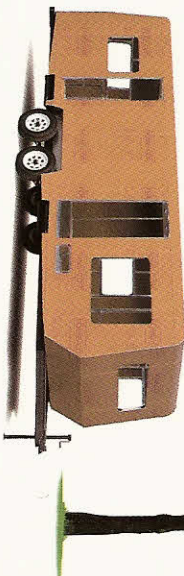

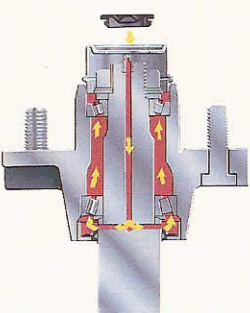
A Sound Investment
