



# **Standard Construction Features**

- Our 5" TuffShell<sup>™</sup> vacuum-bonded crowned roof is stronger than those used by other manufacturers (R-21).
- 5. Ducted A/C venting
- 6. Extra-strong TuffShell<sup>™</sup> vacuum-bonded sidewalls are constructed with aluminum framing. Everything is anchored to the floor, so the floor supports the weight of the walls (R-9).
- 7. Welded aluminum framing
- Insulated in-floor ducted heating distributes heat evenly and frees up more space for cabinets (R-22).
- 9. Strong 5/8" plywood flooring is tongue and groove, so seams stay firmly attached.
- 10. Our rugged, double-stacked 12" tubular steel frame is stronger and won't flex as much as the typical Cchannel frame most RVs are built on, so Designer is more rigid and stable.
- 11. An R-22 value is achieved by combining R-15 bubble foil insulation and R-7 blanket insulation. Puncture-resistant PolyFlex<sup>™</sup> and bubble foil insulation line the underside of the flooring. Holding tanks are insulated and heated and the underbelly is fully enclosed.
- 12. End caps are one-piece molded fiberglass. They lend a sleek aerodynamic look and they're dentresistant, too. Repairs, if required, are easy.





It is important for your safety and enjoyment that your tow vehicle be adequately sized and equipped to tow and handle the GVVR of the RV you select. Review weights and rating of your tow vehicle and consult a competent advisor for questions or advice. Whether you are new to RVing or a veteran, get a feel for the performance of your tow vehicle and the RV together before heading out on the roadways. When you tow an RV, you must drive differently than you do when driving a single vehicle. Practice hooking up, driving, backing up, and braking in a safe environment or seek out professional instruction. Jayco affixes a weight label to each RV which lists weight information for that vehicle. See specification chart above. Unloaded Vehicle Weight (UVW): Sometimes referred to as "Dry Weight," UVW means the typical weight of this trailer as built at the factory. The UVW, as used in product literature and other promotional materials, does not include cargo, fresh water, propane, options, or dealer-installed accessories.

Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR): GVWR means the maximum permissible weight of the trailer, including the UVW plus passengers, personal items, all cargo, fluids, options, and dealer-installed accessories. The GVWR is equal to or greater than the sum of the UVW and the CCC.

Cargo Carrying Capacity (CCC): CCC means the maximum weight of all passengers, personal items, food, fresh water, propane, tools, other cargo, and dealer-installed accessories that can be carried by the trailer. CCC is equal to or less than GWMR minus UVW. The addition of options will decrease the CCC.

Hitch Weight (HW): The hitch weight, as used in product literature and other promotional materials, does not include cargo, fresh water, propane gas, options or dealer-installed accessories. The addition of these types of items will either add to or subtract from the stated hitch weight.
