

It all rides on a new Dodge chassis with new front and rear suspension systems and special silencers to make driving smooth and easy. Looking out through the big new panoramic windshield you know that this one is built for the road. And for you.

... in Convenience

In addition to the "understood" comforts you would expect in a luxury motorhome, The Custom luxury includes a host of convenience features not as immediately apparent as a refrigerator or a bathtub.

There is, of course, a complete kitchen with a big 8 cubic-foot gas/electric refrigerator, eye level oven over the range and everything else you need for entertaining and just plain living in style. And there's a full bath with tub and shower; and lounge or twinbed comfort when it's time to turn in.

A standard 4,000 or 5,000 watt auxiliary power plant on all Custom models gives you the power to run all accessories without any outside power supply. Start switches are on the dash so you can start your power plant as you drive down the highway. At a real savings of battery life. The power plant and

on removable sliding

trays to make servicing


easy and economical.

The power plant compartment is super soundproofed.

Your battery change-over switch is also mounted on the dash, allowing one-man operation in conjunction with the power plant. It has a momentary dual position which could be especially important should your batteries be low. (It lets you use the 60 Amp automotive alternator with the power of both batteries for starting the power plant, if necessary.)

Holding tanks. The Customs have a dual system. One just for waste; one for dish, bath and sink water. You selectively dump either one.

Plus there's a host of other sensible convenience features that are seldom noticed until they're needed. Like outside entrance lights, easy outside access to the engine compartment (no greasy shoes soiling plush carpeting), a Motor Aid water heater that heats water as you drive, outside sewer hose compartment, a wall mounted thermostat to set the forced air furnace for just the right warmth in every nook and cranny. And more.



Run your hands over the rich wood cabinetry in a Custom and notice how all edges are smoothly finished. Look closely at the stainproof and flame retardant upholstery and



drapery fabrics. Open a cabinet and notice the positive latch and snagproof lining.

You might even take off your shoes and walk barefoot in the plush wall-to-wall carpeting. And look up to see that it covers the ceiling, too. To add an extra measure of sound proofing and insulation.

Notice that all aluminum features, inside and out, are anodized for long lasting beauty and durability. Inspect the tough new acrylic surfaced ABS plastics used on tubs and showers.

Ask your dealer to explain the total quality of the Customs from top to bottom.

It's all very beautiful. But built for years of RV living. And since Winnebago builds most every component that goes into it, you're assured of rigid quality control over all fabrics, materials and workmanship.



...in Details

Attention to detail is a Winnebago tradition. It goes back to establishing one's own criteria for what is outstanding workmanship in a motorhome and what is not.

Over and above the obvious luxuries offered by our Custom models, we believe exacting standards in unseen, important details are equally as important in providing outstanding value.

Details like double sealing all windows and vents with silicone to prevent leaking, and



installing plastic vents over the weep holes for the same purpose. And special double-flared fittings on all plumbing and LP gas lines. Which cost more, and take more time, but also provide tighter, longer lasting connections.

We use hollow core doors in our new Customs. Like those found in quality houses. They're lightweight to help keep a low center of gravity on the coach. And they resist warping. Most other manufacturers use solid wood or particle board.

An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure, the old adage goes, and it's certainly true when you're building a motorhome. The small plastic deflector on our air-cooled power plants, for example. You have to look under the power plant tray to find it. It prevents the power plant's powerful exhaust from kicking up sand or other particles which could enter the air-intake and cause expensive damage. A small feature, but one that could save you plenty of money and one that is illustrative of our care for what we make.


Plus there's a big vanity with deluxe medicine cabinet and power roof bath vent. And with the privacy door closed, a dressing room complete with double wardrobe.



- For the period of one year from the date of purchase—air compressor, air conditioner (auto), air conditioner (roof), antenna, axles (TT), auxiliary battery (MH), battery (TT), brake assembly (TT), converter, speed control, demand pump, furnace, hitch (TT), LP gas bottle(s), power range hood, pre-finished panelling, range, radio, refrigerator, sink, stereo, vacuum cleaner, gauges, water conditioner, toilet, and water heater.
