
Surprisingly, you'll find that even the cab is spacious. We redesigned the motor cover to give you noticeably more room and to make it easier to get in and


out of the front seats.

The dashboard is a new design as well. It's automotive in styling, beaut function. Exclusively Elanda With a thoughtfully considered layout that makes all the information you need easy to find and easy to read.

The instrument pane is designed for serviceability. A portion of the padded dash removes for easy access to all instrumentation.

Even the defroster vents are improved. Rather than simply being bolted on as in other motor homes, the Elandan has strategically positioned vents molded into the dashboard and each front door to defrost all cab windows efficiently.





IT'S TIME CO-PILOTS GOT A DOOR OF THEIR OWN.

Lots of motor homes have an optional cab door. But only for the driver. The Elandan offers two front doors—each with a sliding window, courtesy lights, and a steel door well, with built in step and slide-out battery tray.

Typical of the Elandan's superior construction, these are not typical motor home doors. They close easily, seal tight, and have the solid automotive feel of their steel framing.

There are a few other unique features in the cab. The windshield wipers were especially designed and

built for the Elandan.

The result is a solidly constructed pantograph wiper system that cleans more windshield than ordinary wipers.

Other cab conveniences include a secure interior hood release, multi-adjustable sunvisors, an AM/FM/cassette tape player and stereo sound

system, tilt steering wheel and map light.

There's also an ambient temperature gauge — it's a handy little device that tells you the temperature inside and outside. With a digital readout, of course.

As impressive as the cab may be, we think you'll agree that the living areas have been thought out just as carefully.

Lighting is recessed beneath the overhead cabinets for a clean, uncluttered look. Drapes, too, are integrated beneath the cabinetry.

Even the optional pulldown bunk is integrated into the ceiling design so that it practically disappears when not in use.

Of course, we were just as careful in choosing the bedroom mattress. It's a Sealy Posturepedic. The very best they make.

But the nicest features of the bedroom are still the three large windows. They turn the room into a sunroom. Curtains, shades and sheers, tucked neatly under a padded valance, offer all the privacy you need.

Bathroom privacy is provided by sliding doors that separate this area from the bedroom and galley.

Wood framed mirrors and brass-tone faucets and towel bars give the bathroom a luxurious look. For extra convenience, we added a removable clothes rod to the shower for drip drying or for temporary clothes storage.

The tub/shower deserves a special mention. The walls and ceiling are molded from a single piece of plastic. The resulting enclosure is strong, durable and leak free. It comes complete with a skylight.

It's one more example of the creative thinking and sophisticated manufacturing techniques that make the Elandan so innovative inside and out.

OUTSIDE, IT'S WHAT YOU DON'T SEE.

You won't find a corner seam on the front of the Elandan. Or any exposed body rivets or fasteners. Or a bumpy, pebbled surface. For good reason.

The Elandan is designed to slice through the air smoothly, cleanly. The aerodynamics of the vehicle

involve far more than just the dramatic 40-degree rake of its front end.

Rather, it's a combination of reduced frontal area, rounded sidewalls, wraparound bumpers, sculptured rocker panels and integrated side mirrors. Together they cut wind resistance and give you superior aerodynamic performance.

The sculptured lines of the Elandan flow right into the rear cap. Molded from one piece of fiberglass, it incorporates built-in spare tire and sewer hose compartments.

There are plenty of other exterior storage compartments. All are seamless, tightly sealed and made of tough plastic. With doors that prop open to free your hands. There are lights in all the luggage compartments and a porch light beside the door.

The Elandan is an exciting improvement in motor home design. And it can't be copied by any other manufacturer. For only Winnebago Industries has the advanced technology needed to build a vehicle of this scope.

Under its 57 acres of

roof, the Winnebago Industries facility is a marvel of ultra-sophisticated manufacturing capabilities and advanced computer technology.

Our 1,000 foot, conveyor-fed assembly lines are miles ahead of the competition.

Specialized computers help us design our motor homes. Still other computers analyze those designs for

strength and balance.

Steel parts for the cab of the Elandan are dipped in a series of 22,000 gallon tanks. They are cleansed with acid, rustproofed with iron phosphate, and primed with paint bonded into every seam and curve by a 400-volt electrical charge.

WHEN IT COMES TO QUALITY AND SAFETY, WE DROP EVERYTHING.

The Elandan has passed countless tests with flying colors.

On the assembly line, professional inspectors check all aspects of craftsmanship, fit, finish, and final results.

But the testing actually began long before the Elandan reached the assembly line.

It began with the most dramatic test of them all—and possibly the most important—the famous Winnebago drop test.

We took a real Elandan, loaded it to 12,800 lbs. (the design wet curb weight of the unit), and dropped it 36" onto solid concrete.

Not a single window broke. Or even cracked. All three doors remained closed—but opened easily for emergency exit. All appliances and cabinets stayed safely in place.

According to Winnebago's Testing Laboratory Supervisor, "It was the most impressive drop test we've ever run."

After the drop test came the accelerated endurance test. A prototype Elandan proved itself in a demanding trial that subjected it to thousands of miles worth of bumps, swerves, stops, screeching turns and assorted wear and tear.

The Winnebago drop test and endurance test show our commitment to

making each of our motor homes as safe and dependable as possible.

And they demone the uncompromising stardards of quality and performance which make the Elandan the most exceptional Winnebago ever built.





The best way to fully appreciate the new Elandan is to compare it to other motor homes. Not from a distance, but close up. Side by side.


When you do, we know the Elandan will come out on top.



The Elandan front end is smooth, rounded, with aerodynamic side mirrors. In vivid contrast, the Cross-Country has protruding corner seams, bolt-on mirrors and a patchwork of both pebbled and smooth fiberglass.

The Elandan has a smooth, sculptured fiberglass sidewall. Wheel lips and rocker panels flow together as integrated units. On the Pace Arrow, exposed rivets and fasteners reveal a less modern assembly technique.

Compare It To Other Motor Homes. No Competition.



The Elandan is full sized. The Pace Arrow has a shorter ceiling, smaller dinette, less floor space and lower counter tops that can be a real pain in the back to use.

Some manufacturers think "what you don't know won't hurt you." But we build in quality even where you'll never see it. Like inside the walls, under the floor and on the roof. The Elandan roof is strong, well-sealed and durable. The Pace Arrow. It speaks for itself.

The windshield wiper system on the Elandan was specially designed and built for the Elandan. Its articulated, pantograph system is mounted in the steel substructure to minimize the effects of torque and vibration. The more expensive Sportscoach, like many other brands, merely attaches the wipers to the fiberglass front.


The Elandan instrument panel is clean and uncluttered. Even removable beverage tray is integrated into the design. The Elandan driver's compartment matches, and perhaps even surpasses, the far more expensive Sportscoach.

No comparison here. The Elandan has two cab doors. No other manufacturer, regardless of price, gives you a Class A with that option. The Pace Arrow doesn't even offer one front door. More importantly, ours are solid, steel-framed, automotive-styled doors—not simply modified sidewall sections.


Pull off the molding strips, and you'll discover two ways to install a windshield. The Elandan windshield is framed in steel, and secured by the same adhesives and sealants used by auto makers. Pace Arrow uses a rubber molding to mount the windshield onto the fiberglass.


The rear bumper doesn't really affect performance. But the Elandan clearly looks better. And its integrated styling means that signal lights are built in, not bolted on — as on the Pace Arrow.
